Steps:

Step 1: Take the NOCTI Medical Assisting Assessment.

Step 2: After meeting the required score (75.4%) on the Medical Assisting assessment, register to take the CMAC Exam.

Step 3: Receive and review CMAC Exam study materials.

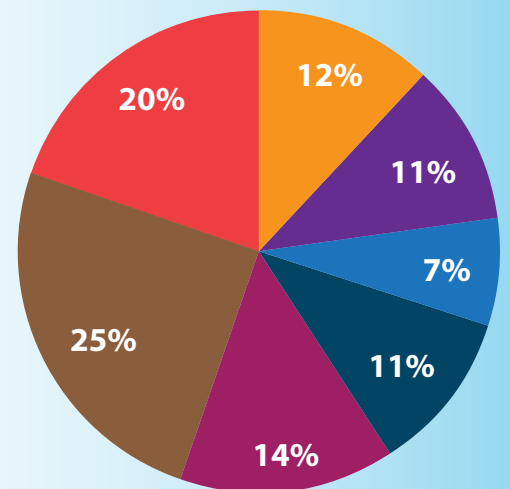
Step 4: Take the CMAC Exam.

Step 5: After meeting the required score (73.0%) on the CMAC Exam, complete and submit a certification application form to AMCA.

Step 6: Receive CMAC certification, Phlebotomy Technician certification, and EKG Technician certification!
