Submit it!

Eligible videos must be produced during the 2017-18 school year and submitted to NOCTI by January 31, 2018. Review the rules and requirements in this packet to ensure your video meets the contest specifications.



Win it!

Winners will be selected and prizes awarded during NOCTI's February 2018 CTE Month Celebration. The winning entry will be the most engaging and memorable video that captures the message of the theme. The prizes are:

- First Place – \$500.00 and a class pizza party
- Second Place – \$250.00 and a class pizza party
- Third Place - \$150.00 and a class pizza party
- Honorable Mention(s) - \$100.00 and a class pizza party



INSTRUCTIONS

- Read and follow all the NOCTI Video Contest Rules, Requirements, and Restrictions.
- Label your DVD or CD with the Entrant's name, the school name, and the title of the video. Do not send your original video master.
- Mail completed Entry Form, Video CD or DVD, and Talent Release Forms to the address below. A carrier with the ability to offer package tracking is recommended.
- Deadline: Entries must be postmarked on or before January 31, 2018.

RULES, REQUIREMENTS, & RESTRICTIONS

Notes:

- The term "Contest" refers to NOCTI's 2018 Video Contest.
- The "Contest Sponsor" is NOCTI, 500 N. Bronson Avenue, Big Rapids, MI 49307 (www.nocti.org).
- The "Entrant" is the teacher who will serve as the designated representative to enter the contest and accept prizes/awards on behalf of the students at a secondary school.
- A "Video" is any Contest entry submitted September 1, 2017, through January 31, 2018.
- Entering the Contest is free; there are no fees involved.
- For NOCTI logo usage request form and guidelines see page 7 of this packet.

Requirements for All Videos:

1. The Video must be based on the theme: Rock the NOCTI!
2. The Video submitted must be student work with minimal assistance from instructors.
3. Multiple videos may be submitted by the same secondary school and/or program. However, multiple videos may not be submitted by the same student(s) and must have different video participants.
4. The Video must not exceed 2 minutes in length. This time limit does not include the required information slate at the beginning of the video. (See next bullet.)
5. Information Slate – A 10-second, full screen slate (title screen) must appear at the beginning of the Contest Video and must include the following information: *(Please use white letters on a black background to make slate easily readable.)*
 - Student participant names
 - Entrant (Teacher) name
 - Producer/Director name(s)
 - School address
 - School name
 - Video title
 - Program name
 - Total running time
6. Entrant must have permission of all persons appearing in the Video or, if persons under age 18 appear in the Video, entrant must have the permission from the parent or legal guardian (see Talent Release Form). Entrant must provide all Talent Release Forms to the Contest Sponsor along with Entry Form and Video.
7. The Video must be created specifically for the NOCTI Contest and cannot have been previously submitted for another promotion or contest of any kind or previously displayed through any other means.
8. Once Entrant's Video has been submitted, the entry is final and may not be modified or edited and no submissions will be returned.

Video Content Restrictions:

1. The Video must not contain material that violates or infringes another's rights, including but not limited to privacy, publicity, or intellectual property rights or that constitutes copyright infringement;
2. The Video must not disparage the Contest Sponsor or any other person or party affiliated with the promotion and administration of this Contest;
3. The Video must not contain brand names or trademarks other than those of the Contest Sponsor, which Entrant has a limited license to use for the sole purpose of creating a Video for this Contest. (See page 7 for logo use info.) There are no restrictions on using images of NOCTI products in the Video (e.g., Banners, Classroom Posters, Study Guides, Countdown Kits, Assessment Blueprints).
4. The Video must not contain any copyrighted music, footage, images, or artwork;
5. The Video must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous, or libelous;
6. The Video must not contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred, or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or age; and
7. The Video must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of or contrary to the laws or regulations in any jurisdiction where the Video is created.

Technical Requirements:

- The Video must be submitted on a CD or DVD.
- Although there is no specific file size limit, the Contest Video must fit on one (1) CD or DVD.
- The format of the Contest Video will be at the creators' discretion; however, the video must play through a Windows computer using Windows Media Player. The file format should be .Mp4, .Avi or .Wmv with a 16:9 aspect ratio.
- Before submitting, test the Video to verify it plays using Windows Media Player. Verifying that the Video plays using Internet Explorer will not guarantee it can be viewed using the above mentioned applications.
- The chosen application viewer must not require the download of add-ons in order to play the Contest Video.

Disqualifications:

- Video submissions postmarked after January 31, 2018 will be disqualified.
- Videos shorter than one minute or longer than two minutes will be disqualified.
- Videos violating any of the restrictions or requirements listed above in this document will be disqualified.
- Videos submitted from post-secondary students will be disqualified.
- Disqualification is at the Sponsor's sole discretion.

JUDGING**Videos will be judged on the following criteria:**

- 50% - Message and appropriateness to theme
- 20% - Creativity
- 20% - Originality
- 10% - Production Quality

Winner Selection:

- All Videos will be pre-screened, prior to judging, to verify compliance of all contest rules.
- A panel of judges selected by NOCTI from the CTE/NOCTI community will choose the winning Videos based on the judging criteria and compliance with all contest rules.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- Winners will be notified by phone and/or email after CTE Month in March 2018.
- Winning Videos become the property of NOCTI, and may appear on NOCTI's website and/or may be promoted through other media outlets.
- Should it be determined that there are insufficient entries worthy of being selected as a finalist, NOCTI reserves the right to select fewer than the stated number of winners in any category. In the event the Video Contest has been impaired or corrupted for any reason and as a result cannot be offered or completed as planned, NOCTI reserves the right in its sole discretion, to cancel or terminate the contest.
